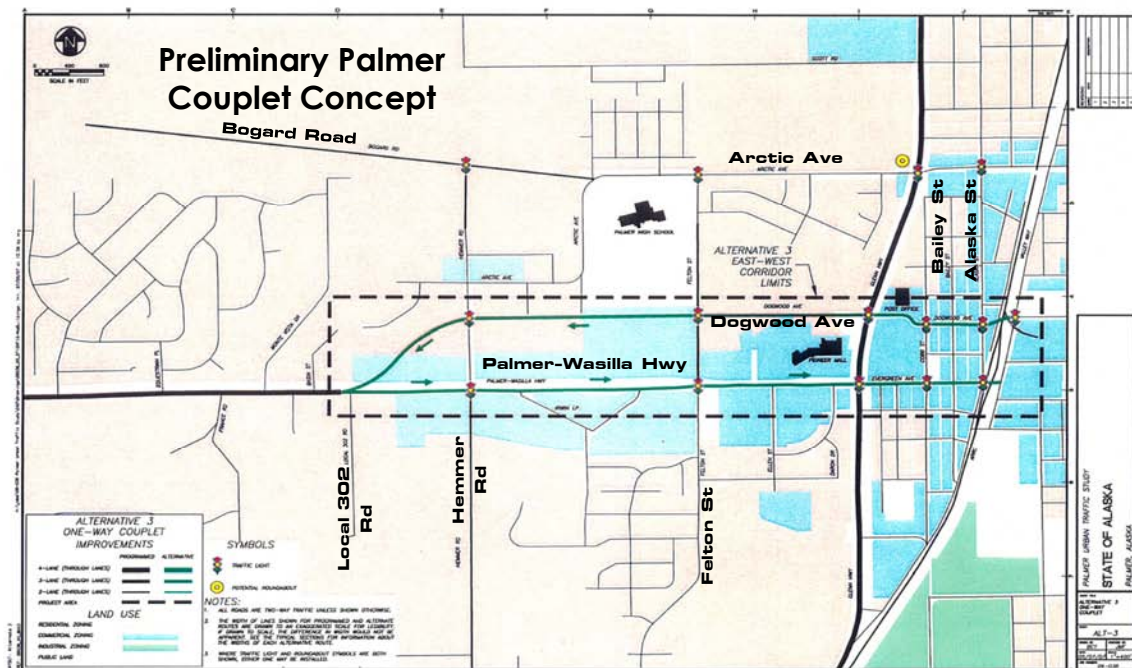
PALMER-WASILLA HIGHWAY

Project Overview

In an effort to alleviate congestion and address future traffic concerns at the intersection of the Glenn Highway with the Palmer-Wasilla Highway/Evergreen Avenue, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities is proposing to convert the east terminus of the Palmer-Wasilla Highway into a one-way couplet. Based on the recommendations presented in the Palmer Urban Traffic Study, the Palmer-Wasilla Highway and Evergreen Avenue will provide three lanes for eastbound traffic and Dogwood Avenue will be extended to provide three westbound lanes from the Palmer Central Business District (CBD) to beyond Hemmer Road. When built, this project will serve to increase safety, service, and capacity, as well as increase circulation within, and access to, the existing CBD. The project is funded by legislative appropriation of State General Funds.
